They operate submarine rescue systems for the following navies; Australian, Singaporean and NATO. They also provide operational support and team training for the Korean and Chinese navies.

James Fisher has built complete submarine rescue systems for the Singaporean and Korean navies.

During this visit you will be introduced to the current Australian submarine rescue system, including;

- The LR5 manned rescue submersible
- SC45 ROV
- Transfer under pressure system
- The LR5's portable launch and recovery system



You will also have the opportunity to watch a video from recent operations, have a talk from some of the JFSRS staff and have access to the equipment.



Registration is open initially to members only and FOC providing attendance is made on the day.

Credit card details will be required to book your place and should you not attend on the day then there will be a \$30 charge to your card.
